> Children are bullied in schools on the basis of their actual or perceived sexual orientation or gender identity, or that of their parents. States must protect them.





Discrimination against LGBT children and young adults is associated with higher rates of suicide than their peers. States must act to overcome prejudice.

> Young LGBT persons are subjected to harmful so-called "therapies" intended to "modify" their orientation or identity. Such therapies are unethical and unscientific and may be tantamount to torture.





Young LGBT people face rejection by their families resulting in high rates of homelessness. States must provide shelters and other safety mechanisms for their protection.

Laws that criminalize people on the basis of their sexual orientation or gender identity further exacerbate violence against LGBT youth. These laws should be repealed.







Intersex children are subjected to medically unnecessary, irreversible surgery without their consent. States should prohibit such interventions.
